For generations, police officers in Chicago have used dogs as partners to assist them in solving crimes and keeping communities safe. Today, approximately 70 canines help our officers protect the city every day. They are invaluable partners that are highly skilled and trained to serve law enforcement professionals in a variety of capacities. As a tribute to the important work the Chicago Police Department's Canine Unit dogs perform every day, the Chicago Police Memorial Foundation is launching the Chicago K9s for Cops public art campaign. Additionally, a portion of the proceeds will be earmarked for PAWS Chicago to benefit the rescue and adoption of dogs in the city.

PETS ARE WORTH SAVING

PAWS Chicago (Pets Are Worth Saving) is a national model in No Kill animal sheltering. PAWS has helped to reduce the number of homeless pets euthanized in Chicago by more than 80 percent since its founding in 1997. In the last five years alone, PAWS Chicago has found homes for 28,542 homeless pets, spayed or neutered 89,839 cats and dogs and trained 15,039 volunteers to be part of the solution. In 2016, PAWS Chicago found homes for over 5,100 homeless pets through its Lincoln Park and Highland Park Adoption Centers and performed over 17,000 spay and neuter surgeries through its Lurie Clinic and GusMobile Spay/Neuter Van. This partnership will help PAWS Chicago continue to provide residents with free spay/neuter services and medical care for their pets through the PAWS for Life program. The PAWS for Life program works on the ground in underserved communities of Chicago to remove barriers to humane pet care, which helps keep pets in their homes.
