# Letter from our President and CEO and Board Chair

# DEAR MAGNIFICENT MILE ASSOCIATION MEMBER,

The past few years have presented a myriad of challenges, any of which would have been detrimental on its own. Collectively, a slow return to the office workforce, higher than normal retail vacancy rates, concerns about safety, and rising property taxes have multiplied in their impact. Yet together we are making progress in reimagining The Magnificent Mile. Our resilience and responsiveness have resulted in new, innovative programs and we are on course for our brightest future, ever. That bright future includes stemming crime in our district, increasing the desirability for property owners to build and buy here, and giving people more reasons to visit The Mag Mile more often.

In 2022, the Association expanded its role into new areas and recommitted to events that define our district. Specifically:

We prioritized Safety & Security. Maintaining a safe and secure district has become a shared responsibility among state agencies, local law enforcement officials, and the Association. As such, our partnerships with the State's Attorney's Office and the Chicago Police Department have been essential in addressing crime and bringing perpetrators to justice. Our launch of Special Service Area (SSA) 76 under the leadership of the five commissioners was a catalyst for change in how we own key safety initiatives in our district. Plus, the addition of a Director of Safety and Security to the Association staff and the launch of the Ambassador program showed that we are serious about curbing the crime rate in our district. We also set the groundwork for legislation to authorize the City of Chicago, other municipalities, and counties to establish Business Improvement Districts (BIDs). Securing BID status for our district would provide the future support we need to continue our safety and security efforts long term.

We brought new experiences to The Avenue and filled vacant storefronts with vibrant limited engagement retail experiences. Partnering with World Business Chicago, we assumed lease agreement responsibility and aided in the marketing of four unique Michigan Avenue storefronts: The Nordic House, The Argentine Connection, The Chicago Food Stop, and The Kavi Gupta Gallery. Each of these retail locations offered consumers products and experiences that can only be found on The Mag Mile. We delighted residents, workers, and visitors with **new artwork and sculptures**. Staying true to our heritage, the district was adorned with engaging art, including The Wings of Mexico sculpture in the Plaza of the Americas and La Catrina at the corner of Michigan Avenue and Ohio Street. We secured funding from the City of Chicago to lighten and brighten lower Michigan Avenue with three "Undercurrent" murals from local artists. "Undercurrent" quickly became our most popular post on social media and is an initiative we will look to expand upon in the future.

Along with our partners at the Lamar Johnson Collaborative, we advanced discussions on M-Vision and accelerated the process to bring our vision to reality. We began gathering input from members and property owners, and together with the M-Vision Taskforce are committed to finding the path forward and delivering the reimagined Magnificent Mile we need.

We again celebrated love of all kinds with our third **Weddings at Wrigley** and welcomed a new title sponsor to **The Wintrust Magnificent Mile Lights Festival**\*. These marquee in person events bring people to the Avenue and remind them why The Mag Mile is so special.

With your partnership and support, we will continue to evolve our district in fresh, new ways that deliver upon the "only on The Magnificent Mile" experiences for which we have always been known.

# 2022 Year in Review: Top 10 Milestone Achievements





Wintrust joined Mickey Mouse and Minnie Mouse of Walt Disney World® Resort, Santa Claus and hundreds of thousands of people on The Mag Mile for The Wintrust Magnificent Mile Lights Festival® on November 19. Also supported by Enjoy Illinois and AT&T, our beloved holiday tradition continued to capture hearts across America, with the ABC 7 broadcast airing in 99% of the U.S. and the live event delivering more than \$14.5 million in attendee spending.

## FORTY COUPLES WERE MARRIED AT WEDDINGS AT WRIGLEY

On October 1, The Wrigley Building transformed into a wedding venue for the second Weddings at Wrigley: An Enchanted Evening. Micro-receptions followed along Michigan Avenue, as a live DJ, food vendors, and cirquestyle performances entertained crowds in Pioneer Court. Weddings at Wrigley also received The International Downtown Association's Downtown Achievement Award of Excellence for the astonishing improvements made to the urban space.







Effective January 1, 2022, Special Service Area (SSA) 76 came into existence. The 5-member commission focused their efforts on safety and security through hiring a safety and security consultant, issuing two security camera rebate programs, and hiring off-duty law enforcement for the holiday season. In the new year, the SSA will build on its security efforts, develop customer attraction programs, and make investments to attract new businesses. The Magnificent Mile Association enjoyed a return to in-person events in 2022 and celebrated several successful district activations. ## TWO NEW SPECTACULAR OUTDOOR SCULPTURES WERE ADDED TO THE MAG MILE

The Wings of Mexico in Plaza of the Americas and La Catrina at the corner of Michigan Avenue and Ohio Street have become favorite photo spots among residents and visitors alike. If you haven't had a chance to see these grand sculptures live, be sure to visit them soon as they are only here for a limited time.

### 5 FOUR NEW LIMITED ENGAGEMENT EXPERIENCES OPENED

We, along with our partners at World Business Chicago and the City of Chicago, secured funding and interest for four new experiences in our district:

The Nordic House provides visitors with an immersive experience of the Nordic region through images and videos, and offers the best of what the respective Nordic countries have to offer in food and culture. The Argentine Connection offered a culturally-infused experience where visitors found an array of Argentine clothing, home goods, area rugs, and fresh baked empanadas.

The Kavi Gupta Gallery opened in November with the third iteration of SKIN + MASKS, curated by Vic Mensa and Chanelle Lacy. The group show features a variety of emerging and established Chicagobased contemporary artists. SKIN + MASKS is made possible through the collaboration by EXPO CHICAGO and The Magnificent Mile Association with Kavi Gupta Gallery. Special thanks to the City of Chicago for sponsorship. This program is also sponsored by the American Rescue Plan.





The Chicago Food Stop is Chicago's first food industry showcase, featuring small-batch goods from across the city. You can even find Caruso's Giardiniera produced by the family of fellow Mag Mile Association Board member, Peter Caruso.





### TWO GLOBAL PREMIERES DEBUTED

The Magnificent Mile® was selected to premiere both Prince: The Immersive Experience and Harry Potter: Magic at Play this year. Yes, the only place in the world where you can record "Purple Rain" in Prince's studio and drink ButterBeer® is on Michigan Avenue.

### LOWER MICHIGAN AVENUE WAS BRIGHTENED BY LOCAL ARTISTS

The Undercurrent project brought art and beauty to lower Michigan Avenue with installations from three local artists. The artists were asked to create a "mirror" image of what was above below, and we are amazed by what they created. The installations can be found on the walls at The Realtor Building (Billy Goat Tavern) and InterContinental Chicago Magnificent Mile and serve as a brighter and safer route for commuters and visitors walking Lower Michigan Avenue.



## THE MAGNIFICENT MILE CHARITABLE FOUNDATION DONATED \$25K FOR THE ALL STARS PROJECT OF CHICAGO

The Magnificent Mile Charitable Foundation presented \$25,000 to the All Stars Project of Chicago (ASP of Chicago) in support of their new Hub for Afterschool Development. Our contribution will be matched by Chicago philanthropists and ASP friends, resulting in \$50,000 of support for a new Hub for Afterschool Development in the heart of downtown Chicago. ASP's Development School for Youth helps young people ages 16 to 21 experience a variety of improvisational, personal development, and coaching experiences through which they learn to succeed as professionals with opportunities for paid internships with participating businesses.



### OSAKA, JAPAN WELCOMED US TO OUR SISTER CITY

Kimberly Bares represented The Magnificent Mile in Osaka, Japan in celebration of our Sister City/Sister Street relationship. During the insightful week-long trip, Kimberly participated in a joint session with the City of Osaka and The City of Melbourne on sustainability.
