Mayor Lightfoot and Governor Pritzker announced a statewide order for Illinois residents to stay at home or their place of residence starting Saturday, March 21, 2020, at 5:00 p.m. This order requires all residents of the state of Illinois to stay at home, **except for essential needs** like going to the grocery store, a doctor, to care for someone or work at an essential job.
